2004 Alfasi Hire established in Melbourne to supply EWPs for several local Alfasi Steel Construction projects.



2010 Alfasi Hire opens our first interstate branch in Sydney to supply equipment for CPB on the RNS Hospital project.



2013 Alfasi Hire awarded key long term equipment supply contracts on tier one resource projects in QLD (WICET and Curtis Island) and WA (Roy Hill and Yandicoogina).



2018 Alfasi Hire expands to Asia setting up a trade house in Malaysia to accelerate second hand machines sales and signs a distribution dealership with Almac Italy.

2008 Alfasi crane division is launched, purchasing a range of Liebherr cranes to support infrastructure and mining projects.



2011 Alfasi Hire expands into QLD, setting up its Brisbane branch along with a Hunter Valley office in NSW.



2019 Alfasi Hire opens a second branch in the Western suburbs of Melbourne to service major projects as well as the Geelong and Ballarat regions.



2021 Alfasi Hire completed its largest CAPEX program, purchasing more than 1000 EWPs, telehandlers, cranes and forklifts, growing the fleet to more than 2500 machines.
